Common themes were identified and are presented in this summary.

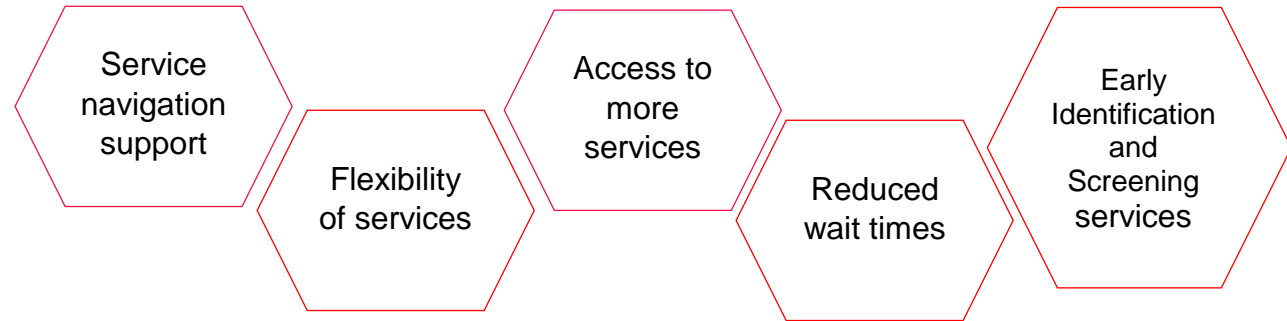
